Planters and other objects must be removed from the blacktop areas and sidewalks so they do not impede the snow removal equipment. When there is a snowfall, vehicles parked in the visitor parking **must be removed** so snow removal can be accomplished. To help with cost containment and to make sure the appropriate amount of salt/calcium chloride is used on the roads, walkways, and porches, please notify Stuart Sanderson, T.H. Management immediately if you observe an excessive amount is applied to these areas. The Management Company will address this issue with Wintergreen, TB I & II's snow removal vendor.
